

AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ENTERED INTO MINDWISE, S.A.P.I. DE C.V. WITH THE COMMERCIAL NAME BEO WORLD, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "BEO WORLD" HEREIN REPRESENTED BY C. IVY MOLINA MOYA AND ON THE OTHER HAND KARLA PEREZ MARTINEZ, , WHO IS THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE STUDENT HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "THE CLIENT" AND AS A WHOLE "THE PARTIES".

R E C I T A L S

I. BEO WORLD declares:

- a. That it is a company incorporated in accordance with the Mexican legal provisions whose constitution is recorded in Public Deed which is attached to this contract for all legal purposes and is represented in this act by C. Ivy Molina Moya, Director of Treasury and Finance who states that as of today, her powers have not been modified or revoked in any way.
- b. That its representative is identified by passport number 16167926 issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Mexico.
- c. That its address for the purposes of this Agreement is located at Avenida Mario Pani # 400, 1st floor, Suite 100, Colonia Santa Fe, Cuajimalpa, Mexico City, C.P. 05348, Mexico and with Tax ID Number (RFC) MIN230719MW0.

II. THE CLIENT declares:

- a. To be the natural person who holds the legal custody of the STUDENT and be the one who will sign, pay and manage everything necessary for the execution of this Agreement. As well as being the contact person for BEO WORLD, from whom the information necessary for the execution of this Agreement will be requested. And this information is detailed in Annex 1 of this contract.
- b. That he is aware of the content of this Agreement and is aware of the rights and obligations acquired at the time of its signing.
- c. That this Agreement is subject to the suspension condition consisting of the accreditation of the payment of the registration fee, so long as there is no record of the payment in accordance with the quotation that is integrated into this Agreement as Annex 2, there will be no type of contractual relationship between THE PARTIES, being exempt from any type of liability arising from this Agreement.

III. THE STUDENT declares, through the CLIENT:

- a. That the information required by BEO WORLD regarding STUDENT data for the purposes of this contract and that is integrated as Annex 1 is true.
- b. That is willing to be a fundamental agent of change through the proper focus of their knowledge, experience and thinking in all activities involving the PROGRAM and/or SERVICES. And is aware that the ethics and conduct norms that govern the EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION extend to its participation in the PROGRAM and/or SERVICES provided by BEO WORLD.
- c. That in the event of contravention of the rules of ethics and conduct, they will be expelled from the PROGRAM and/or THE SERVICES, taking responsibility for the costs that this implies.

By virtue of the foregoing, both parties have agreed by mutual agreement on the following:

C L A U S E S

ONE. Purpose of the Agreement. BEO WORLD undertakes to provide the CLIENT with professional educational travel experience services in accordance with the BEO WORLD PROGRAM catalog published annually on the website: www.beo-world.org , likewise, makes available to THE CLIENT the possibility of contracting additional SERVICES to THE PROGRAM, such as: airfare sales, planning additional travel extensions to THE PROGRAMS including: accommodation, transportation and extra activities.

TWO. Consideration. The CLIENT undertakes with BEO WORLD to pay the total amount of \$4,690.00 USD for the provision of professional services consisting of THE PROGRAM and/or SERVICES in accordance with the quotation(s) attached to this Agreement in which the payment schedule(s) is determined, the first of which is the registration fee.

THREE. Enrollment. The CLIENT undertakes with BEO WORLD to pay the non-refundable amount of \$1,000 USD at the time of signing this Agreement , as a PROGRAM registration fee. The remaining balance for the total cost of the PROGRAM must be settled on the dates described below according to the PROGRAM and/or THE CONTRACTED SERVICES and in accordance with the payment schedule established in Annex 2.

a) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is December 15 prior to travel date.

b) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of June and July of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is April 30 prior to travel date.

In the event that the totality is not settled on the date established in this Clause, the CLIENT undertakes with BEO WORLD to pay the amount of \$150 USD as a conventional penalty for each month of delay in fulfilling the obligation.

FOUR. Airfare. Airfare. BEO WORLD offers the CLIENT the SERVICE for the sale of airfare in accordance with the following guidelines:

4.1. THE CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the price for airfare for the year in which it has been contracted in accordance with the payment schedule established in Annex 3.

4.2. The CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the non-refundable amount of \$900 USD, at the time of acceptance of the quotation that is integrated as Annex 3 of this Agreement, as a section. From that moment on, it will not be possible to cancel, make changes, request refunds, vouchers, or, if applicable, to transfer funds.

4.3. The payment deadline to settle the cost of airfare according to the PROGRAM and/or THE CONTRACTED SERVICES is as follows:

a) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is December 15 prior to travel date.

b) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of June and July of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is April 30 prior to travel date.

4.4. In the event that the outstanding balance for air tickets has not been settled, BEO WORLD reserves the right to cancel the purchase without the right to a refund, exchange, redemption, or any other form of substitution by the CLIENT.

4.5. THE CLIENT may request a new quote from BEO WORLD, this being completely independent of the initial quote, which could reflect increases in prices, airlines and flights.

In this case, once the quote has been accepted by the CLIENT, it must make the full payment of the airfare.

FIVE. Travel extensions. BEO WORLD offers the CLIENT the SERVICE of travel extension in accordance with the following guidelines:

5.1. THE CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the price for the travel extension for according to the established the payment schedule pursuant to Annex 4.

5.2. THE CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the non-refundable amount in accordance with the payment schedule established in Annex 4. From that moment on, it will not be possible to cancel, make changes, request refunds, vouchers, or, if applicable, to transfer funds.

5.3. The payment deadline to settle the travel extensions according to the PROGRAM and/or THE CONTRACTED SERVICES is as follows:

a) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is December 15 prior to travel date.

b) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of June and July of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is April 30 prior to travel date.

5.4. In the event that the outstanding balance for travel extensions has not been settled, BEO WORLD reserves the right to cancel the purchase without the right to a refund, exchange, redemption, or any other form of substitution by the CLIENT.

5.5. The CLIENT may request a new quote from BEO WORLD, this being completely independent of the initial quote which could reflect increases in prices, airlines, flights, ground transportation, hotels and other experiences originally quoted. In this case, once the quote has been accepted by the CLIENT, it must make the payment in accordance with a new calendar and through the execution of a new Agreement.

SIX. Extra activities. BEO WORLD offers the CLIENT the SERVICE of extra activities in accordance with the following guidelines:

6.1. THE CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the price for the extra activities according to the established the payment schedule pursuant to Annex 5.

6.2. THE CLIENT undertakes to pay BEO WORLD the non-refundable amount in accordance with the payment schedule established in Annex 5. From that moment on, it will not be possible to cancel, make changes, request refunds, vouchers, or, if applicable, to transfer funds.

6.3. The payment deadline to settle the extra activities according to the PROGRAM and/or THE CONTRACTED SERVICES is as follows:

a) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is December 15 prior to travel date.

b) For BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of June and July of each year: the deadline to pay off balance is April 30 prior to travel date.

6.4. In the event that the outstanding balance for extra activities has not been settled, BEO WORLD reserves the right to cancel the purchase without the right to a refund, exchange, redemption, or any other form of substitution by the CLIENT.

6.5. The CLIENT may request a new quote from BEO WORLD, this being completely independent of the initial quote which could reflect increases in prices, dates, places and types of extra activity. In this case, once the quote has been accepted by the CLIENT, it must make the payment in accordance with a new calendar and through the execution of a new Agreement.

SEVEN.- The time, form and place of payment. The CLIENT undertakes with BEO WORLD to make the payment in accordance with the following guidelines:

7.1. Payment for enrollment in the program must be made at the time of signing this Agreement.

7.2. Balance for the cost of the PROGRAM and/or additional SERVICES quoted may be made in accordance with the payment schedule established in Annex 2 and/or 3 and/or 4 and/or 5

7.3. Payments may be made by: (a) bank transfer; (b) PayPal; (c) Credit cards; (d) Debit cards; (e) Window deposit; (f) Zelle; (g) Deposit in dollar account. For this purpose, THE CLIENT undertakes to send BEO WORLD the proof of payment to the email payments@beoeducation.co.uk indicating in the subject of the email the name of the student, educational institution, program and year of travel. Emails without the requested information cannot be identified.

EIGHT. Term of the Agreement. From the date of signature of this Agreement and until the conclusion of the PROGRAM and/or delivery of THE SERVICES.

NINE. Cancellation and/or Non-Transferability and/or Expulsion of the STUDENT. The cancellation of THE PROGRAM and/or SERVICES, as well as the right of BEO WORLD to expel the STUDENT are delimited in the following manner:

9.1. When for any reason the EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION of which THE STUDENT is a part, does not have the minimum number of students required to form a group before the date set forth below:

- a) BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: deadline to form a group is December 15 prior to the travel date.
- b) WEE Canada and International Experience to be held during the months of June and July of each year: deadline to form a group is April 30 prior to the travel date.

BEO WORLD will have the right to cancel THE PROGRAM and/or SERVICES for that group. THE CLIENT will have the right to a full refund of the payments made within 45 business days following the date on which the EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION notifies BEO WORLD in writing of the impossibility of completing the group.

9.2. When for any reason THE CLIENT cancels before:

- a) BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: deadline to cancel is December 15 prior to the travel date.
- b) WEE Canada and International Experience to be held during the months of June and July of each year: deadline to cancel is April 30 prior to the travel date.
- c) the payment made for registration will not be refunded; (d) The other payments made will be refunded. If the willingness to cancel THE PROGRAM and/or THE SERVICES occurs after that date, no refund will apply.

9.3. When for any reason, THE STUDENT does not have the documents required by the authorities of the countries through which they will travel, including, among others, a valid passport and valid visas: (a) the payment made for registration will not be refunded; (b) The other payments made will be refunded, with the condition that the cancellation request is made before:

- a) BEO, WEE, The Masters, International Experience and WEE Canada to be held during the months of March and April of each year: deadline to cancel is December 15 prior to the travel date.

b) WEE Canada and International Experience to be held during the months of June and July of each year: deadline to cancel is April 30 prior to the travel date.

If the request to cancel THE PROGRAM and/or THE SERVICES is made after that date, no refund will apply. In the event that the STUDENT travels without any of the requirements required by the authorities of the countries through which they transit, THE CLIENT will bear all expenses arising therefrom.

9.4. To validate the cancellation process, THE CLIENT is obliged to make the request through the cancellations button on the BEO WORLD PAYMENT PORTAL and in accordance with the cancellation policies of the annex. Within the following 10 business days, BEO WORLD will notify THE CLIENT if the request was approved based on the cancellation policies of the annex as well as the terms thereof. Once the response to THE CLIENT has been formalized and if the request is accepted, BEO WORLD will make the corresponding refund within 45 calendar days thereafter.

9.5. There will be no refund of any amount after THE PROGRAM and/or SERVICES contracted have begun, even if they have not been used by THE STUDENT.

9.6. THE PROGRAM and/or THE SERVICES are non-transferable.

9.7. The student who does not respect the rules and code of conduct of BEO WORLD will be suspended from THE PROGRAM and/or THE SERVICES without the right to a refund and may be returned to their country of origin if the BEO WORLD operations team deems it appropriate. THE CLIENT must cover the expenses related to the return of THE STUDENT such as land, air transportation, hotels, insurance, among others.

TEN. General Contract. Once this contract is signed, THE PARTIES are obligated to comply with all the terms and conditions stipulated in the general service provision contract, which forms an integral part of this contract, so that at no time may any obligation of the present contract and the aforementioned general contract be unfulfilled, which can be consulted at PAGE XXX.



ELEVEN. Act of God or Force Majeure. BEO WORLD shall not be liable for the breach of any obligation to this Agreement to the extent that the breach is caused by acts of God and/or force majeure. For the purposes of this Agreement and the Law, an act of God and/or force majeure event is understood as: Any event beyond the reasonable control of BEO WORLD and which is: (a) insurmountable; (b) unforeseeable; and (c) through no fault of BEO WORLD, including but not limited to, acts of God, war, insurrection, riots, civil unrest, acts of terrorism, fire, explosion, flood, theft, malicious damage, strike, lockouts, weather, third-party mandate, national defense requirements, public health emergency, pandemics, and acts or regulations of national or local governments.

Once the existence of Force Majeure has been declared, beo WORLD will not be responsible for the return of the payments made by the CLIENT, it will only be responsible for the continuation of the fulfillment of its contractual obligations, so once the fortuitous event and/or cause of force majeure has been overcome, it must inform the CLIENT, the new dates available for the PROGRAMS and/or SERVICES that have been affected and, where appropriate, the additional costs, time, form and place of payment for rescheduling that the CLIENT will have to pay.

TWELVE. Entire Agreement. This Contract, its annexes, and the general service provision contract constitute the entire agreement between THE PARTIES with respect to the object thereof, thereby replacing all prior contracts, commitments and agreements, whether verbal or written, that THE PARTIES may have entered into and agreed upon with respect to the object of this Contract, and they agree to the content of the clauses of this instrument, its annexes and the general service provision contract, as they are not contrary to law, morality, or good customs, and there is no deception, injury, bad faith, or any vice in their consent that affects them.


